There is no airport in Koh Tao, so the best way to get here is to travel to the southern part of Thailand and catch a high-speed ferry.





### Bangkok - Chumphon - Koh Tao

Nok Air and Thai AirAsia both fly direct from Bangkok's Don Mueang Airport to Chumphon. Upon arrival, a shuttle bus will take you from Chumphon Airport to Lomprayah Pier. Ferry tickets to Koh Tao can be included in the ticket price, which pretty much guarantees that you won't miss your connection. Alternatively, you can travel overland from Bangkok to Chumphon by road or rail. Your choice depends on your time, budget and travel preferences.

# Bangkok - Koh Samui - Koh Tao

Bangkok Airways flies direct from Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi Airport to Koh Samui. Upon arrival at Samui International Airport, you can arrange a transfer to Koh Tao through the airport information desk. Three companies operate ferries from Koh Samui to Koh Tao: Lomprayah, Songserm and Seatran Discovery. Please note however, that these operators depart from different locations

on Koh Samui, so be sure to check your ticket and go to the correct ferry terminal.



### Bangkok – Surat Thani – Koh Tao

Several airlines fly direct from Bangkok to Surat Thani, including THAI Smile from Suvarnabhumi Airport and Nok Air, Thai AirAsia and Thai Lion Air from Don Mueang Airport. Upon arrival, a shuttle bus will take you from CHUMPHON Surat Thani Airport to Surat Thani Pier. This can be included in the ticket price - please check with your airline. Guests arriving from other locations in the south, such as Phuket, may wish to travel overland to Surat Thani pier.

The ferry times are listed below, but please note that these times are subject to change and weather conditions. Please double check the times on the operators' websites.

# ARRIVING IN KOH TAO

Upon arrival at Mae Haad Pier, Koh Tao's main arrival and departure point, please look for our staff representative who will be holding a "Haad Tien Beach Resort"

MANGO BAY signboard. He will be located at the counter No. 6.

Haad Tien Beach Resort offers complimentary transfers to and from Mae Haad Pier, Koh Tao's main arrival and departure point. This service operates all-year-round on the resort's exclusive shuttle bus, and is available to all guests. The travelling time between the pier and the resort is approximately 15 min.

Please note the transfer schedule below:

Departs Mae Haad Pier lobby: 09.30, 10:30, 14:30, 15:30, 19.15 and 22.00 hrs Departs Haad Tien Beach Resort: 08.30, 14.00 and 18.30 hrs

To book our transfer service, please inform us at least two hours in advance. Also, please reconfirm your arrival details prior to your stay.

All arrivals and transfers will be coordinated at Mae Haad Pier lobby. Other guests may arrive on different boats, so there may be a small waiting time (rarely more than 30 min). But we always aim to keep waiting times to a minimum.

Upon departure, your transfer will take the same route as when you arrive, but we will allocate extra travelling time to ensure that you arrive at the pier in plenty of time to catch your boat.

Resort check-in time: After 14.00 hrs Resort check-out time: Before 11.00 hrs

We will always try to accommodate an early check-in (before 14.00 hrs) and late check-out (after 12.00 hrs) when requested, however this may not be possible during periods of high occupancy. In these situations, we will try to allocate temporary accommodation to the arriving or departing guest, if it is available.
